Works

Anyone travelling on Broomehill-Kojonup Rd and Tambellup West Rd will be aware of the significant road works in progress. Gravel widening was completed on Broomehill-Kojonup Rd in readiness for sealing. Unfortunately the weather was working against the program, causing some problems with the sealing process. While sealing work has ceased here for the time being until weather conditions are more suitable, a crew has been on site widening culverts and replacing headwalls.

Reconstruction of a 4.7km stretch of Tambellup West Road has commenced. It appears the existing road structure has been compromised by stumps and tree roots over many years and repairs will involve the deep ripping of the existing bitumen so a stable gravel road base can be established before resealing. Motorists are asked to obey warning signage in the vicinity of road works, and reduce speeds accordingly. The maintenance graders have been working in the north western part of the shire, and are heading to the north east. With the recent rain, heavy formation grading has commenced.

Council's Jetpatcher truck has been in demand in recent months, with the Shires of Tammin, Plantagenet and Cranbrook all utilising it for bitumen repairs.

Southern Link Voluntary Organisation of Councils (VROC)

The VROC Councils of Broomehill-Tambellup, Plantagenet, Kojonup and Cranbrook are in the process of completing a joint business case to be submitted to the Department for Regional Development, for funding to assist with the provision of seniors accommodation in the region. This project, if accepted, will be funded by the regional component of the Country Local Government Fund allocation for 2012-2013.

While our Tambellup units are nearly at the point of going to tender for construction, the communities of Cranbrook and Kojonup in particular have an identified need for additional seniors housing, with long waiting lists for existing accommodation in both towns. As such, the funding application will focus on the construction of additional housing in those towns.

In addition, it is planned to utilise some of the funding to carry out a needs analysis to determine the need for similar accommodation in Broomehill. More information will be made available to residents in this regard once an outcome from the application is known.

Thanks to these people for their support and commitment to the smooth operation of our local brigades, and thank you to outgoing Fire Control Officer Peter Guazzelli for his efforts with Broomehill Central brigade.

Following the close of the public notice period, Council has resolved to raise a loan of \$120,000 to assist with renovation to the library and reception area at the Broomehill Administration office. The loan will be repayable over five years.

Council endorsed the Ten Year Plant Replacement Program, which provides for the progressive renewal of the Shires fleet over the next ten years. By adopting this program, Council is able to streamline the fleet, increase usage of major plant items and reduce the cost of changing over vehicles.

Council Elections

Council elections will be held in October this year, with four positions on Council becoming vacant. If you have ever considered serving your community through this avenue, and would like to find out more about the role, you are encouraged to contact any of the serving Councillors, or alternatively, the Chief Executive Officer, who can provide more information.

All pensioners are reminded that in order to claim the Pensioner Rebate in 2013 the amount due on your rate notice needs to be paid (in full) before 30 June, 2013. If you think you may be eligible for a rebate and require further information, please contact Kay O'Neill at the Shire. If you haven't registered as a pensioner please do so as soon as possible. We will require a copy of your pension card.

Thumbs Up

Thank you to all those people who have been removing the posts out of their old fence wire before delivering it to the rubbish tip. Aside from making the process of compacting the wire easier, scrap metal merchants will not accept fencing wire with posts. Your cooperation in this area is appreciated.

Just a Reminder

When taking melons to the tip, it would be appreciated if they could be deposited in the pit rather than in the green waste dump. This helps to stop the spread of this weed at the tip site.

SHIRE PRESIDENT'S NOTES

Now is the time to start thinking about our local Council elections due to be held in October this year. October will come upon us as usual, quicker than we realise so it pays to start thinking about it now. Nominations will be called for four positions. Advertising will ramp up in the next few months so keep and eye out for the opening of the nomination date.

This election sees at least three Councillors retiring so please give some thought to taking on a role with your local Council, don't just assume that these positions will be filled by someone else. A great opportunity exists for you to make a difference and guide your council and community into the future.

The talk of Council amalgamations in the regional shires seems to have slowed but the threat still remains. One of the biggest triggers for Shires perceived to be unsustainable is the lack of contested elections. That aside, if we wish to be self governing then it is up to the individual to stand for office.

Local government is no longer just Roads, Rates and Rubbish it's about creating a desirable place to live that is vibrant, prosperous and safe with a Council that always strives to ensure financially responsible decisions are made. Local Government has a role in fostering community development and plays an important role regionally.

All you need is a passion for your community, a desire to put your views as well as listen to others, a willingness to work as a team member, to ensure where possible that future planning meets the needs of generations to come, to be open and accountable and work towards providing the best possible outcomes with responsible financial decision making. Vibrant Councils need renewal and with that comes new views as well as new ways to look at old perennial issues.

It's not as hard as it sounds - sure as in life, we cannot guarantee that every decision in hindsight is the right one but we can make decisions with the right motive and intent. There is no place for self interest, negative or obstructive views in a Council that functions properly. Councillors need to put their views strongly but abide by the majority decision and to work towards a common goal.

The Shire of Broomehill-Tambellup has been fortunate that so far we have been served by Councillors with that belief, but it is up to us to ensure that it continues and not to be complacent and just assume others will fill the role.

Everyone who becomes a Councillor finds that their view of how local government operates changes once they take the position on. Rules apply that ensure good conduct, good decision making including guides to ensure conflicts of interest don't occur. Financial implications are well thought through and every decision is backed up by sound advice from our CEO, staff and external organisations such WALGA our state body, or consultants who offer advice on planning, health and environmental issues.

There are many challenges however there are few roles that allow you to really make a difference in your own community. I sincerely urge you to think about standing. I know like all the Councillors I have met, when you do, you will be glad you did.

If you would like to talk to me, one of the other Councillors or to Jo at the office regarding the role, please do so as I am confident we have the right people in our community to do the job successfully.


2013 BLOOM FESTIVAL

OVARIAN CANCER FUNDRAISER


